Learning Center.



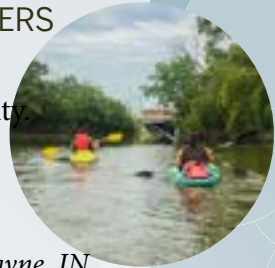

AFTERNOON

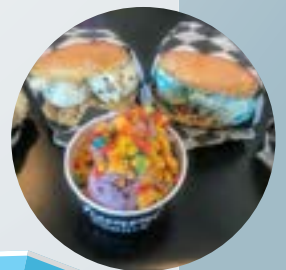
**HISTORIC OLD FORT**
