Day 1

MORNING

NAHANT MARSH

4220 Wapello Ave., Davenport, Iowa

A 265-acre nature preserve next to the Mississippi River in southwest Davenport, Iowa.



AFTERNOON

PUTNAM MUSEUM

1717 W. 12th St., Davenport, IA

The museum features an active schedule of permanent and changing exhibits. A variety of exhibits for adults and kids.



EVENING

JOHN DEERE PAVILION

1400 River Dr., Moline, IL (FREE)

The John Deere Pavilion celebrates the American heartland from the first horse-drawn plow to the latest modern-day combines and tractors that people can climb on.



Day 2

MORNING

RIDE CHANNEL CAT WATER TAXI

1415 River Dr., Moline, IL (or 4 other stops)

A 47-passenger boat that takes visitors to the five landings around the Quad Cities in a continuous loop throughout the day from Memorial Day-Labor Day.



QUAD CITY BOTANICAL CENTER

2525 4th Ave., Rock Island, IL

A breathtaking tropical paradise with plants native to nearly 100 different tropical destinations. + children's garden

AFTERNOON

FAMILY MUSEUM

2700 Learning Campus Dr., Bettendorf, IA

10,000-foot interactive exhibit hall with daily drop-in activities. The permanent Lil 'Sssippi River Valley explores the bridges and there is 28-foot waterplay table that resembles the Mississippi.
